General notes

1. Before considering the document, it is a good idea to write a few notes of the deal you have agreed in principle, then to make sure that each item you have noted is covered in the document. 2. This agreement is designed to cover both low and high value transactions. What may be suitable for an animal worth \$10,000 may be excessive for one worth \$500. There are no governmental regulations with which you need to

4. Transactions with horses and ponies tend to be badly recorded and frequently result in litigation as a result. You are therefore advised to insert your own agreed terms, in areas where this version may not reflect the transaction you have agreed. Do not buy the horse until
