## General notes:

1. This is an agreement providing rules for the running of a riding club where the association is just a members' club which is not run by a company and does not
2. A terms and conditions document serves two prime purposes: first, it sets out the terms under which you have agreed to accept the contract. Everyone can see the details of the contract between you and your contract party can decide whether or not to enter into a contract on these terms. Secondly, the document affirms the legal rights of the parties, so that each can sue the others in court for
